## DEEPER LIFE MINISTRY

### VISION STATEMENT

It is the vision of Deeper Life Ministry to develop a prayer and ministry facility, available 24 hours a day for the entire body of Christ. We want to prepare a people to receive the embrace of the heavenly Bridegroom, empowering them to walk out the first commandment as wholehearted lovers of God and fulfill the second commandment by reaching out to the community around us.

Our theme will be 3-fold in purpose:

- 1) To reveal the beauty of Christ as a passionate Bridegroom, transcendent King and righteous Judge through worship and spiritual education.
- 2) To bring light into the dark areas of our community by breaking down enemy strongholds through targeted prayer and intercession.
- 3) To fulfill the second commandment by touching the lives of those in our community by providing various outreach ministries and acts of love.

Our ministry facility will be divided into two distinct areas:

- 1) Tabernacle Area- Set aside as a dwelling place for the Spirit of God, this area will be used for intense worship, prayer and intercession. An atmosphere of His presence will be maintained in this room with continuous taped and live worship music.
- 2) Training Area - A special Computer Training Room will be setup for computer based training for various business and Christian applications. A portion of our community outreach will consist of free computer training for those unable to afford it. Satellite conferences and video training sessions will also be available in this area. A Resource Room will also be available, containing books and reference material on worship, prayer and spiritual warfare.

The Holy Spirit is orchestrating a global prayer strategy far eclipsing any other prayer movement in history, which will result in an unprecedented Harvest of souls completing the Great Commission. In cities throughout the earth, it will become common to hear of intercessory worship ministries that continue non-stop 24 hours a day in the spirit of the Tabernacle of David. It is our desire to be a part of this move of God that we believe will consummate with a great end time revival and usher in the coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

## **BYLAWS OF DEEPER LIFE MINISTRY**

### **ARTICLE I - NAME, PURPOSE**

Section 1: The name of the organization shall be Deeper Life Ministry.

Section 2: The Deeper Life Ministry is organized exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes, more specifically to provide Christian and secular training for all individuals regardless of their race, religion or financial condition.

### **ARTICLE II - MEMBERSHIP**

Section 1: Membership shall consist only of the members of the board of directors.

### **ARTICLE III - ANNUAL MEETING**

Section 1: Annual Meeting. The date of the regular annual meeting shall be set by the Board of Directors who shall also set the time and place.

Section 2: Special Meetings. The Chair or the Executive Committee may call special meetings.

Section 3: Notice. Notice of each meeting shall be given to each voting member, by mail, not less than ten days before the meeting.

### **ARTICLE IV - BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

Section 1: Board Role, Size, and Compensation. The Board is responsible for overall policy and direction of the Council, and delegates responsibility for day-to-day operations to the Council Director and committees. The Board shall have up to five and not fewer than three members. The board receives no compensation other than reasonable expenses.

Section 2: Meetings. The Board shall meet at least twice per year, at an agreed upon time and place.

Section 3: Board Elections. Election of new directors or election of current directors to a second term will occur as the first item of business at the annual meeting of the corporation. Directors will be elected by a majority vote of the current directors.

Section 4: Terms. All Board members shall serve two-year terms, but are eligible for re-election.

Section 5: Quorum. A quorum must be attended by at least seventy five percent of the Board members before business can be transacted or motions made or passed.

Section 6: Notice. An official Board meeting requires that each Board member have written notice two weeks in advance.

Section 7: Officers and Duties. There shall be three officers of the Board consisting of a Chair, Secretary and Treasurer. Their duties are as follows:

The Chair shall convene regularly scheduled Board meetings, shall preside or arrange for other members of the executive committee to preside at each meeting in the following order: Secretary and Treasurer.

The Secretary shall be responsible for keeping records of Board actions, including overseeing the taking of minutes at all board meetings, sending out meeting announcements, distributing copies of minutes and the agenda to each Board member, and assuring that corporate records are maintained.

The Treasurer shall make a report at each Board meeting. Treasurer shall chair the finance committee, assist in the preparation of the budget, help develop fundraising plans, and make financial information available to Board members and the public.

Section 8: Vacancies. When a vacancy on the Board exists, the Secretary may receive nominations for new members from present Board members two weeks in advance of a Board meeting. These nominations shall be sent out to Board members with the regular Board meeting announcement, to be voted upon at the next Board meeting. These vacancies will be filled only to the end of the particular Board member's term.

Section 9: Resignation, Termination and Absences. Resignation from the Board must be in writing and received by the Secretary. A Board member shall be dropped for excess absences from the Board if s/he has three unexcused absences from Board meetings in a year. A Board member may be removed for other reasons by a three-fourths vote of the remaining directors.

Section 10: Special Meetings. Special meetings of the Board shall be called upon the request of the Chair or one-third of the Board. Notices of special meetings shall be send out by the Secretary to each Board member postmarked two weeks in advance.

**ARTICLE V - COMMITTEES**

Section 1: The Board may create committees as needed, such as fundraising, housing, etc. The Board Chair appoints all committee chairs.

Section 2: The three officers serve as the members of the Executive Committee. Except for the power to amend the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, the Executive Committee shall have all of the powers and authority of the Board of Directors in the intervals between meetings of the Board of Directors, subject to the direction and control of the Board of Directors.

Section 3: Finance Committee. The Treasurer is chair of the Finance Committee, which includes two other Board members. The Finance Committee is responsible for developing and reviewing fiscal procedures, a fundraising plan, and annual budget with staff and other Board members. The Board must approve the budget, and all expenditures must be within the budget. The Board or the Executive Committee must approve any major change in the budget. The fiscal year shall be the calendar year. Annual reports are required to be submitted to the Board showing income, expenditures and pending income. The financial records of the organization are public information and shall be made available to the membership, Board members and the public.

## **ARTICLE VI - AMENDMENTS**

Section 1: These Bylaws may be amended when necessary by a two-thirds majority of the Board of Directors. Proposed amendments must be submitted to the Secretary to be sent out with regular Board announcements.

## STATEMENT OF FAITH

---

**WE BELIEVE** that only the sixty-six books of the Bible are the inspired, and therefore inerrant, Word of God. It is the final authority for all we believe and how we are to live. Matthew 5:18; John 10:35; 17:17; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20-21.

**WE BELIEVE** that the one true God exists eternally in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and that these, being one God, are equal in deity, power, and glory. We believe that God created the world and also now upholds, sustains, governs, and providentially directs all that exists and that He will bring all things to their proper consummation in Christ Jesus to the glory of His name. Psalm 104; Psalm 139; Matthew 10:29-31; 28:19; Acts 17:24-28; 2 Corinthians 13:14; Ephesians 1:9-12; 4:4-6; Colossians 1:16-17; Hebrews 1:1-3; Revelation 1:4-6.

**WE BELIEVE** that Satan, originally a great and good angel, rebelled against God, taking a multitude of angels with him. He was cast out of God's presence and is at work with his demonic hosts to establish his counter-kingdom of darkness and evil on the earth. Satan was judged and defeated at the cross of Christ and will, at the end of the age, be cast forever into the lake of fire which has been prepared for him and his angels. Matthew 12:25-29; 25:41; John 12:31; 16:11; Ephesians 6:10-20; Colossians 2:15; 2 Peter 2:4; Jude 6; Revelation 12:7-9; 20:10.

**WE BELIEVE** that Adam was originally created in the image of God, righteous and without sin. In consequence of his disobedience, Adam's posterity are born subject to both imputed and inherent sin, and are therefore by nature and choice the children of wrath, justly condemned in the sight of God, wholly unable to save themselves or to contribute in any way to their acceptance with God. Genesis 1-3; Psalm 51:5; Isaiah 53:5; Romans 3:9-18; 5:12-21; Ephesians 2:1-3.

**WE BELIEVE** that Jesus Christ is God incarnate, fully God and fully man, that He was conceived and born of a virgin, lived a sinless life, and offered himself as a penal, substitutionary sacrifice for sinners. By the blood of His cross He obtained for us eternal redemption, the forgiveness of sins, and life everlasting. He was raised bodily on the third day and ascended to the right hand of the Father, there to make intercession for the saints. Matthew 1:18-25; John 1:1-18; Romans 8:34; 1 Corinthians 15:1-28; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Galatians 3:10-14; Ephesians 1:7; Philippians 2:6-11; Colossians 1:15-23; Hebrews 7:25; 9:13-15; 10:19; 1 Peter 2:21-25; 1 John 2:1-2.

**WE BELIEVE** that salvation is by grace alone, through faith alone, in Christ alone. No ordinance, ritual, work, or any other activity on the part of man is required in order to be saved. This saving grace of God, through the power of the Holy Spirit, also sanctifies us by enabling us to do what is pleasing in God's sight in order that we might be progressively conformed to the image of Christ. John 1:12-13; 6:37-44; 10:25-30; Acts 16:30-31; Romans 3:4; 8:1-17, 31-39; 10:8-10; Ephesians 2:8-10; Philippians 2:12-13; Titus 3:3-7; 1 John 1:7,9.

**WE BELIEVE** that the Lord Jesus Christ baptizes believers in the Holy Spirit, in whom also we are sealed for the day of redemption. The Holy Spirit regenerates, forever indwells, and graciously equips the Christian for godly living and service. Subsequent to conversion the Spirit desires to fill, empower, and anoint believers for ministry and witness. We also believe that signs and wonders, as well as all the gifts of the Spirit described in the New Testament, are operative today and are designed to testify to the presence of the kingdom and to empower and edify the church to fulfill its calling and mission. Matthew 3:11; John 1:12-13; 3:1-15; Acts 4:29-30; Romans 8:9; 12:3-8; 1 Corinthians 12:12-13; 2 Corinthians 1:21-22; Galatians 3:1-5; Ephesians 1:13-14; 5:18.

**WE BELIEVE** that water baptism and the Lord's Supper are the two ordinances of the church to be observed until the time of Christ's return. They are not a means of salvation but are channels of God's sanctifying grace and blessing to the faithful in Christ Jesus. Matthew 26:26-29; 28:19; Romans 6:3-11; 1 Corinthians 11:23-34; 1 Peter 3:21.

**WE BELIEVE** that the church is God's primary instrument through which He is fulfilling His redemptive purposes in the earth. To equip the saints for the work of ministry, God has given the church apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers. We also affirm the priesthood of all believers and the importance of every Christian being joined with and actively involved in a local community of the saints. We believe that women, no less than men, are called and gifted to proclaim the gospel and do all the works of the kingdom. However, final governmental authority in the church has ideally been entrusted to men. Matthew 16:17-19; Acts 2:17-18,42; Ephesians 3:14-21; 4:11-16; 1 Timothy 2:11-15; Hebrews 10:23-25; 1 Peter 2:4-5,9-10.

**WE BELIEVE** that God has called the church to preach the gospel to all nations, and especially to remember the poor and to minister to their needs through sacrificial giving and practical service. This ministry is an expression of the heart of the Lord Jesus Christ and is an essential part of the kingdom of God. Isaiah 58:6-12; 61:1; Matthew 28:18-20; Luke 4:18; 21:1-4; Galatians 2:10; 1 Timothy 6:8.

**WE BELIEVE** in the literal second coming of Christ at the end of the age when He will return to the earth personally and visibly to consummate His kingdom. We also believe in and are praying for a great end-time harvest of souls and the emergence of a victorious church that will experience an unprecedented unity, purity, and power in the Holy Spirit. Psalms 2:7-9; 22:27-28; John 14:12; 17:20-26; Romans 11:25-32; 1 Corinthians 15:20-28,50-58; Ephesians 4:11-16; Philippians 3:20-21; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-5:11; 2 Thessalonians 1:3-12; Revelation 7:9-14.

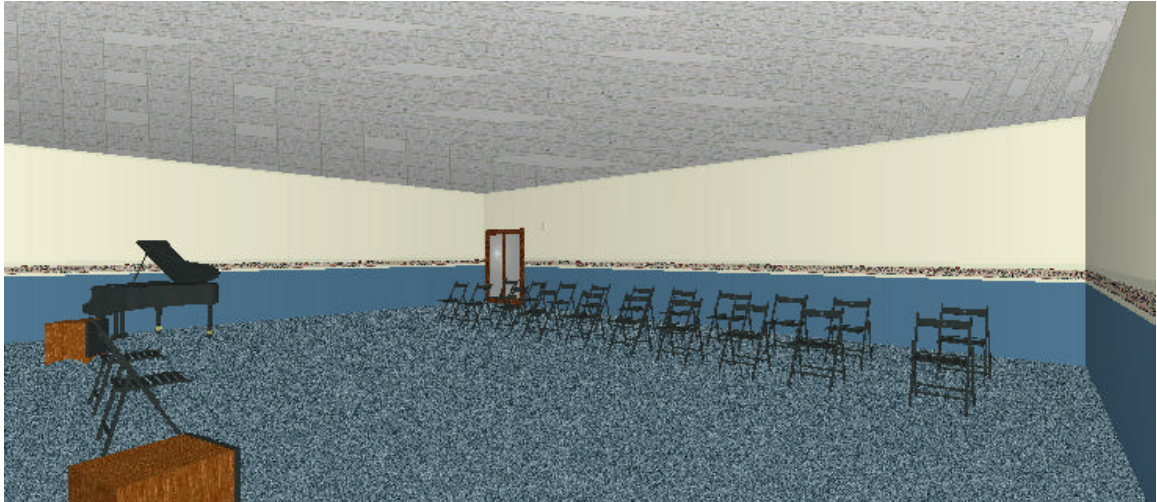

## **PRAYER AND PRAISE CENTER MANDATE**

### **I. The Essence Of Prayer**

The fundamental nature of all prayer is a deepened relationship with God, made possible through redemption by the blood of Jesus Christ and enjoyed by all who put their faith and trust in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Prayer is the pathway to intimacy with the Father, involving both speaking and hearing from God. Prayer must not be regarded as a way to manipulate God to our point of view rather it serves to tune us, so we may have a deeper understanding of the love, grace, will, purpose and timing of God. We must also recognize that the fulfillment of Gods purpose for a particular circumstance in history is many times contingent upon effectual prayer.

### **II. Prayer And Personal Spirituality**

Through the centuries the saints of God have enjoyed the privilege of prayer as a way of deepening their personal holiness. Numerous classics in Christian literature have emphasized, “practicing the presence of God.” Many have felt that their primary service to God consisted of a lifetime of personal waiting upon Him and bring pleasure through praise and worship. Prayer and reading of God’s Word is the means by which we obtain our direction in life.

### **III. Diversity In Intercessory Prayer**

All forms of intercession are rooted in the biblical conviction that prayer releases God’s power and grace in the lives of those prayed for. However, there are diverse areas of intercessory prayer. Many areas of intercessory prayer should be practiced by all Christians. Husbands should pray for their wives and vice versa; parents should pray for their children; believers should pray for their church and spiritual leaders; citizens should pray for those in authority; just to name a few of the more obvious areas.

Intercessory prayer is focused prayer. These prayers might be focused on a particular group or person, such as your church or an unsaved loved one. It may also be focused on breaking a stronghold of the enemy in a particular area, such as your town or neighborhood.

Intercessory prayer may require fasting. Fasting allows us to deny are physical needs in order to accomplish a spiritual need.

### **IV. The Primary Assignment**

The Prayer and Praise Center mission is centered on enhancing the relationship of the individual with their Heavenly Father by revealing the beauty of Christ as a passionate Bridegroom and to bring light into the dark

areas of our community by breaking down enemy strongholds through targeted prayer and intercession. It is the responsibility of every Christian to provide the Holy Spirit a holy tabernacle in which to dwell. We also desire to provide Him with a physical Tabernacle, set apart and prepared to receive His glory.

## **V. Prayer For Revival**

Another goal of the Center is to mobilize the Body of Christ in this area to pray effectively for area wide evangelization. However, we recognize that many churches in their present state are not able to make significant contributions because they have left their first love and find themselves in a powerless state. Because of this, prayer for what is called revival or renewal or awakening is essential. A desperate need of the hour is for massive spiritual revival within the churches of this area and across the nation. We must come together in unity and pray for a fresh move of God in our homes, our businesses and our churches.

## **VI. Biblical Premise**

We believe that we are engaged in constant spiritual warfare with the principalities and powers of evil that are seeking to frustrate the church in all of its efforts. Several fundamental biblical premises underlie the call to spiritual warfare and prayer. They can be best stated by quoting relevant biblical texts:

- (1) The devil directly and explicitly attempts to obstruct any move toward revival or evangelization and deception is one of his major tools. "But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, whose mind the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them." (2 Cor.4: 3, 4)
- (2) The weapons designed by God to help remove these obstructions are spiritual weapons. "For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God." (2 Cor. 10:4,5)

## **VII. Interdenominational Standards**

To accomplish our task and fulfill the prayer of Christ that they all will be one, we must realize that our constituents will include many from liturgical, evangelical, dispensational and charismatic backgrounds. We must all make adjustments that will not be offensive to the rest. The following statement attempts to set forth standards for any joint prayer events or gatherings.

*Remember that the moment two or more of us unite in prayer we become a symphony. As such:*

- *We blend together in unity respecting the fact that we represent all of Christ's body;*
- *We realize that, like a symphony with its different instruments, there is a wide variety of traditions when it comes to prayer;*
- *We commit ourselves to accepting one another as we are, while disciplining ourselves to use wisdom if we think anything we might do offend our brother or sister.*

We want all of those that participate to be themselves. We must not quench the Spirit. Furthermore, there are no restrictions on prayer styles in prayer groups of like tradition. Yet some of these styles may not be appropriate in groups of mixed traditions.

## **VIII. Conclusion**

This Center will stand or fall on personal relationships rather than on bureaucratic controls. Therefore good will and tolerance is an essential personal characteristic for all who participate. This is a day in which we are seeing a visible spiritual unity of the Body of Christ. We are bold enough to believe that it is the beginning of an answer to Jesus' prayer "that they all may be one that the world might believe". (John 17:21)
